HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTION

The Jesuit Archives & Research Center opened in November 2017, when the Jesuit Archives: Central United States relocated to a new facility and took a new name to reflect the wider geographic coverage of its collections and its mission to be a destination for researchers from around the world. JARC opened for research visits in April 2018.

FONDS DESCRIPTION

JARC houses records from seventeen past and current administrative provinces of the Society of Jesus in the United States. These include the Buffalo, California, Central and Southern, Chicago, Chicago-Detroit, Detroit, East, Maryland, Midwest, Missouri, New England, New Orleans, New York, Northeast, Oregon, West, and Wisconsin Provinces. JARC also houses the records of the governing body of the Society of Jesus in the US, the Jesuit Conference of Canada and the United States.

In addition to administrative records of the provinces, JARC maintains records from and about the Jesuits who were members of these provinces, as well as information regarding apostolates within these provinces and their missions.

HISTORY OF THE FONDS

The history of the fonds at JARC varies depending on the province. Each province's records are maintained as their own collection.
